ASSEMBLY STEP 5

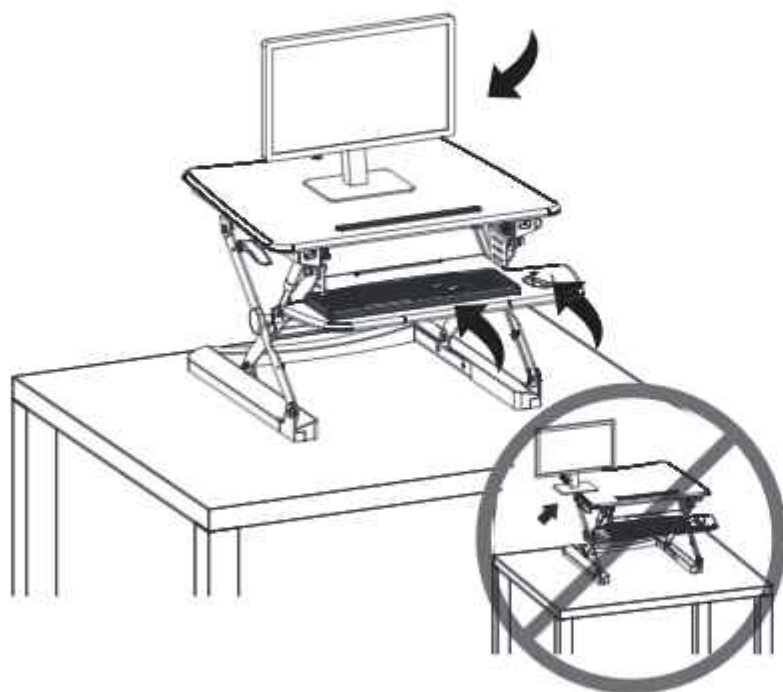

Please put the devices onto the top of the workstation.

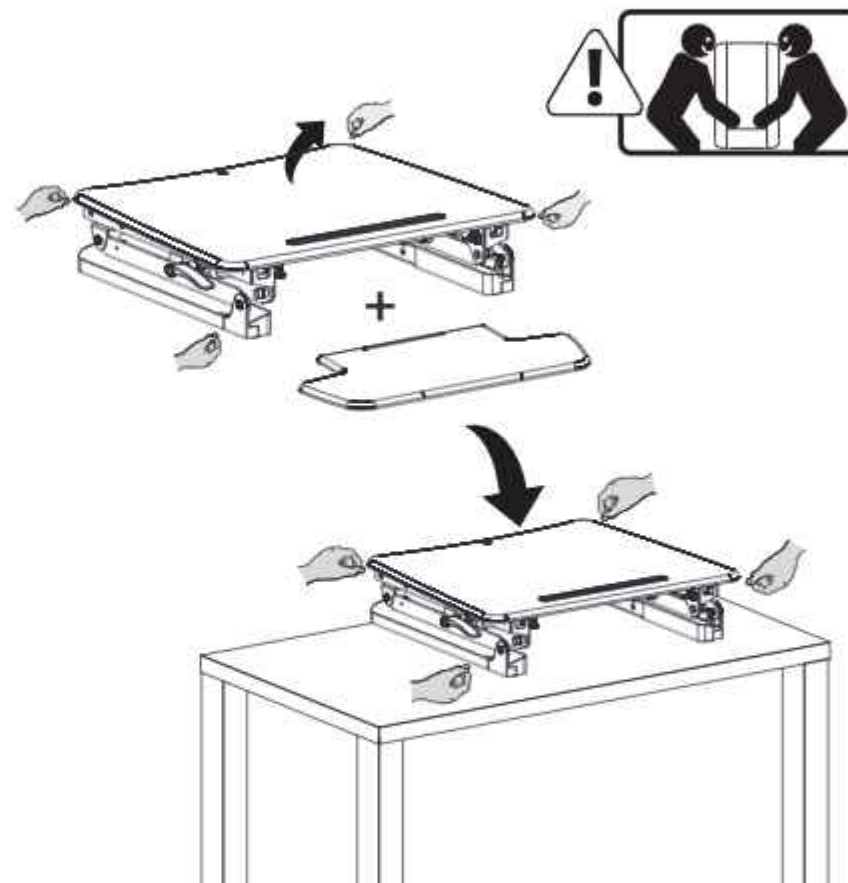

Please take the packaging carton apart, take out the product and place it on the table.



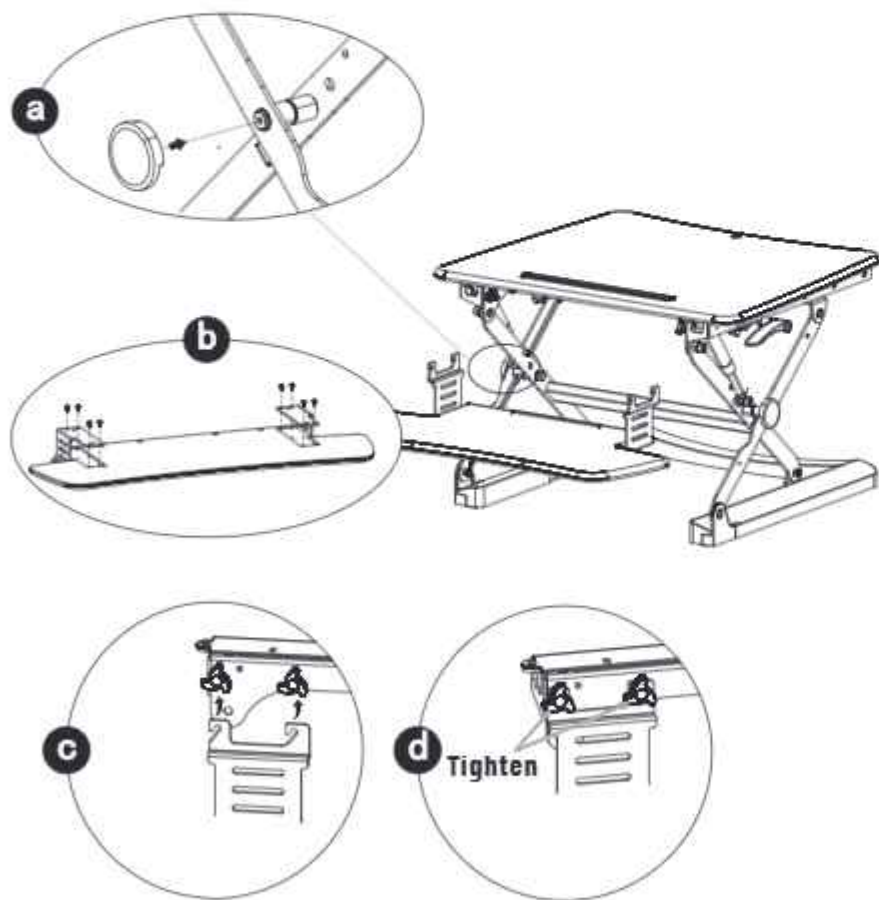

ASSEMBLY STEP 2

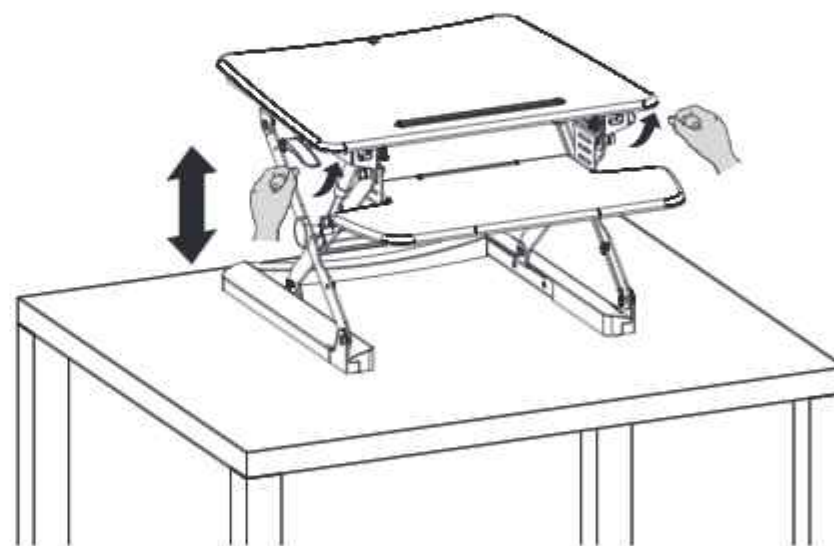
- a :** Buckle decorative cover to the connecting arm.
- b :** Connect and fix the junction plate and keyboard tray by 8 screws and use the cross screwdriver to fasten afterwards.
- c,d:** Hang the junction plate on the knob assembled and then tighten the knob.

Note: Loosen bolts to make sure the keyboard sits securely before tightening



ASSEMBLY STEP 3

Based on the actual usage, press the handle grips both sides simultaneously, and adjust the workstation to the proper height.
